



IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT SUMMER HORSE CAMP

HOURS

Camp hours are 9:00 AM to 4:00 PM, Monday – Friday

If you have a day when you are running late or your camper will not be coming, please call and let us know so we can plan our activities accordingly.

PICK UP

We request written authorization if someone other than a parent or guardian is picking up a camper. We will provide you with a form for this purpose on the first day of camp, but please let us know.

FIRST DAY OF CAMP YOU SHOULD BRING:

OTHER THINGS TO BRING

1. Students should bring a lunch and snack.
2. Please bring a large water jug with the students name on it. (We provide refills of cold water throughout the day).
3. Sunscreen
4. Shorts and shoes to change into for afternoon activities if desired.
5. Horse treats: Apples and carrots are always appreciated!

ATTIRE

- Students must have their own approved riding helmet. (No bicycle helmets, please. Reason: Bicycle helmets do not provide adequate protection in the event of a fall from a horse.)
- Long pants: Close fitting stretch pants, jeans, or riding pants.
- A low-heeled boot, (not Western), or English jodhpur/paddock boots.

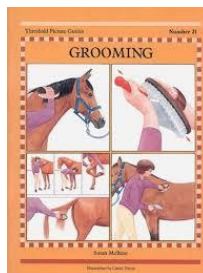
